1. Students will work on having a Christ-like attitude in any situation.
2. No tobacco products, alcohol, drugs, fireworks, inappropriate items, or items used for pranks.
3. Treat all adults courteously and with respect. Use your best manners and politeness towards any adults. Disrespect will not be tolerated.
5. Inside jokes, criticism of others, bullying tactics, sarcastic remarks, foul language/cursing, and the like will not be tolerated.
6. Dress modestly. (No halter-tops, midriffs showing, anything really tight, short shorts, short skirts). During any water-related events at church or off-campus such as beach or pool

activities, no speedos for boys and t-shirts covering bathing suits for girls.

7. No inappropriate pranks or practical jokes ( i.e. jokes, pranks that cause harm to a person or property or result in humiliation of another person).

8. No physical contact between guys and girls or any other public display of affection (PDA). No leaning on each other on the bus/van. When staying overnight, no guys are allowed in girls rooms and no girls are allowed in guys rooms.

9. While visiting any facility, we will abide by any rules that may be in addition to those on this list.

10. The Youth Minister or any other staff member may send any student home that does not conduct himself or herself properly at their parents' expense.

11. All required documents including medical releases and permission forms must be completed for each youth and adult attending off-campus trips/events.

12. Use of cellphones will be limited in specific situations for events/trips on and off church campus. Students must be willing to disengage with cell phones if and when necessary.

This code of conduct form shall be effective until the 1st of January in the year 2024.
